Permit Issuance

All deer harvested under the authority of Managed Land Deer Permits (MLDP) must be tagged with an appropriate MLD Permit. Completion of the hunting license log and use of a hunting license tag are not required for deer harvested under the authority of this permit; therefore, county and statewide antlerless bag limits do not apply to individual hunters. However, a valid hunting license is required for each hunter.

These permit(s) are issued to achieve Wildlife Management Plan (WMP) goals. Completion of certain practices relating to conducting population surveys, collecting and recording harvest data as stipulated, and implementing habitat management practices as outlined in the Wildlife Management Plan are required for eligibility and participation in the MLDP program. Failure to meet eligibility and compliance requirements as outlined will jeopardize your continued participation in the MLDP program.




